It is time again for us to start filling shoeboxes in support of Operation Christmas Child.

The mission of Operation Christmas Child is to demonstrate God's

love in a tangible way to needy children around the world, and together with the local church worldwide, to share the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Please help this great cause. Your simple gift of a shoe box can provide a child with great joy and excitement, as this may be the only Christmas present that they receive.

- **1 Find a shoebox.** Operation Christmas Child boxes are available from church (at no cost). Obtain a label from Hazel, and stick it on your shoebox to show if it is for a girl or a boy and the age.
- **2 Fill with Gifts.** There are a variety of things that can be put into a shoebox including toys, hats, scarves, combs, toothbrushes, soap, pens, stickers, and notepads. Please don't include things such as toothpaste, sweets, food, medicine, liquids or anything fragile or sharp.
- Make your donation. Please include a donation of £5 with each box. This covers the cost of getting the shoebox to a child. Donations can be made online and you an also print off a barcode, add it to the box and this will enable you to track which country your shoebox gets sent to.
- Pray. Lastly, please remember to pray for the child who will receive your gift, and also for all the volunteers who will ensure that your gift gets there.

The shoeboxes will be collected early November. We'll let you know the deadline date in due course. For more information, speak to Hazel Manship or visit the website which includes loads of information and ideas around what to pack.
